Waste container identification with barcode labels

We were able to finish the introduction of the waste container identification system by the end of 2013. Now all waste containers are equipped with barcode labels. The identification system is in the interest of all fee payers as it contributes to a fair fee system (only containers that are registered are emptied, multiple emptyings are avoided), the logistics costs that USK have to pay are reduced and customer service is raised.



IMPORTANT:
Waste containers without barcode labels cannot be emptied anymore!

Depot containers for used textiles/shoes

Since 2013 USK have deployed stationary depot containers that take used textiles and shoes all over the town. These local depot containers are easy to recognize due to their **orange coating** and the USK logo on them.

Choosing the container locations, USK paid attention to good area coverage and good availability. In doing so, they also considered the storage containers of well-known local welfare and non-profit institutions, which USK continue to support.

The use of these storage containers is in the interest of the fee payers as profit this brings immediately goes into the waste disposal budget.

If additional locations are set up, we will inform you accordingly.

Note: Regarding the use of the storage containers and the special collection of recyclable material we ask you to place old textiles and shoes (which should be bundled in pairs) in **plastic bags** before you put them into storage containers or glass disposal boxes. This way they are protected against dampness and dirt.

Special collection of recyclable material:

Since 2013 USK has regularly been pursuing a special collection system in order to pick up certain types of recyclable material. This is done with the help of the glass collection boxes that are used on the day of disposal. Other than that, the collection boxes for the disposal of waste glass are to be used for this.



If you use your collection boxes for the disposal of waste glass, the box volume must not be exceeded. As to weight, the boxes must be filled in a way that they are not damaged during transport!

Every 8 weeks the recyclable materials are collected, namely shortly after the dates for the collection of waste glass (for exact dates see the calendar at the end of this brochure).

- **White box:** Old textiles and shoes (bundled in pairs), packed in plastic bags.
- **Green box:** Assorted small metals (not liquid or combustible metals).
- **Brown box:** Electrical or electronic devices (only small devices) of groups 3 and 5 in accordance with §9 section 4 of ElektroG (information or telecommunication devices, entertainment electronics devices, small household devices, electrical and electronic tools, toys, sports devices, medical products, control and surveillance devices, **no lighting devices**).

“Robbery of recyclable material”: The **recyclable materials placed in the boxes** are given to the **care of USK only**. This also goes for bulky waste. Of course, they **must not be taken away by other collectors**, which, however, we in our experience have to reckon with. Should you observe such an incident, please **notify USK immediately; if possible, give us data like number plate of the collector’s car or similar information**. This is in your interest as the profit that USK make from these collections go into the waste disposal budget.



Which waste goes where?

The grey wastebin

The grey wastebin takes only the so-called "remaining waste", that is, waste that cannot be recycled.

YES, this goes in:

- Only waste which cannot be recycled, such as:
- Fatty, wet paper
 - Vacuumcleaner bags
 - Waxed and oiled paper
 - Hygienic paper such as nappies, paper handkerchiefs or sanitary towels
 - Metals covered with non-metallic materials
 - Video cassettes
 - Objects that consist of different types of metal
 - Window or mirror glass
 - Glass shards, ceramic, porcelain
 - Leftovers of processed food
 - Vegetable fats
 - Out-of-date medicine
 - Rests of wallpaper
 - Hardened paints and coatings

NO, this does not go in:

- Any recyclable waste that is collected in the green and brown wastebins, the glass boxes and the yellow waste bags
- Hazardous materials such as:
- Batteries
 - Fluorescent tubes, energy-saving light bulbs
 - Paints and coatings
 - Acids and alkalis
 - Oils and fats
 - Insecticides and plant protection products
 - Chemicals of all kinds
 - Old clothes
 - Construction work debris
 - Electrical and electronical scrap

The green wastebin

The green wastebin takes old paper as well as paper and cardboard packaging material.

YES, this goes in:

- Newspapers and magazines
- Catalogues, books, files, journals
- Any other clean paper
- Cardboard boxes
- Corrugated cardboard
- Other cardboard materials
- Paper shreds

NO, this does not go in:

- Dirty, fatty and wet paper
- Waxed and oiled paper
- Coated paper or cardboard such as beverage Pizza packaging
- Yoghurt, margarine and ice-cream boxes
- Parchment paper
- Wallpaper
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Hygienic papers such as nappies, paper handkerchiefs or sanitary towels
- Non-paper material such as inlays in chocolates or cigarette boxes

Please note the correct filling of the wastebins!



The yellow wastebag

The yellow wastebags are intended for packaging that is made of plastic, metal or composites and that as a rule carries the "green dot".

YES, this goes in:

- **Metals:**
 - Konserven- and beverage cans
 - Closures
 - Aluminium boxes, lids and foil
 - Spray and coating cans
- **Composites:**
 - Beverage and milk cartons
 - Vacuum packaging
 - Pizza boxes with aluminium coating
- **Plastics:**
 - Carrier bags
 - Plastic bags
 - Dishwasher liquid, washing liquid and body care liquid bottles
 - Dairy product boxes
 - Margarine boxes



NO, this does not go in:

- Metals covered with non-metallic materials
- Batteries
- Packaging that contains hazardous material, such as spray or coating cans that contain CFC
- Silage film
- Extremely dirty packaging

Do you need yellow wastebags?

You can get them at the Kleve local city office, at the Kleve waste recycling centre and at the USK headquarters. Furthermore, you can get yellow wastebags from the USK personnel on the day the waste paper (green wastebin) is collected. Contact the USK personnel directly or leave a corresponding message on the lid of the green wastebin. You will find a roll of yellow wastebags in the empty green wastebin.

The glass boxes

Waste glass is collected in three boxes for white (clear), brown and green glass respectively.

YES, this goes in:

- Any kind of hollow glassware such as bottles or glasses
- White glass into the white box
- Brown glass into the brown box
- Green glass and glass of other colours (blue, black) into the green box



NO, this does not go in:

- Window glass
- Mirror glass
- Porcelain
- Ceramic
- Clay
- Bottle and glass closures (also cork)
- Light bulbs and fluorescent tubes
- Glass shards

The brown wastebin

The brown wastebin takes all organic waste, that is, waste that can be composted.

YES, this goes in:

- Compostable garden and green waste
- Tree-cut remains of up to ten centimetres in diameter
- Roots of bushes or similar plants
- Cut grass
- Leaves
- Flowers and weeds
- Fruit and vegetable waste and similar material that grows in nature

NO, this does not go in:

- Leftovers of processed food
- Material hazardous to nature
- Foreign material such as metals, stones, plastics, big and strong rootwork, household waste
- Animal droppings and bedding material used in pet care

NOTE: GARDEN AND GREEN WASTE

Outside the days when the brown waste bin is emptied it is also possible throughout the year to take garden waste to the USK waste recycling centre in Kleve, 1 Wilhelm-Sinsteden-Straße (at corner Briener Straße), for a fee. Please note the centre opening times.

Special waste Hazardous waste (from households)

Special waste with hazardous content must not be thrown into any of the waste bins or recyclables containers. Liquid special waste must not be poured into the sewage system so that it does not reach the wastewater treatment plant.

YES, this is special waste (examples):

- Petrol
- Waste oil
- Plant protection products
- Spray cans that contain CFC
- Acids and alkalis
- Batteries
- Cleaning liquids
- Solvents
- Glue
- photographic chemicals

Special waste can be disposed of at the special waste disposal vehicle, which stands on different locations in the town area. You can dispose amounts of about 30 kilograms or 30 litres.

GENERAL NOTE:

- Waste containers/yellow waste bags and glass boxes have to be placed for pick-up on the day of disposal by 6am.
- Waste containers must be filled only up to the brim so that containers can be closed. Only then they can be emptied without any problems.

Electric and electronic waste

Devices that carry the symbol “crossed-through waste container” are no usual household waste and must not be thrown into the grey waste bin.

YES, devices such as these are affected:



- Small household devices: irons, toasters, frying machines, coffee machines, ...
- IT/Communication technology: computers, computer screens, laptops, printers, gaming consoles, telephones, ...
- Entertainment technology and photovoltaic modules: radios, TV sets, video recorders, HiFi devices, ...
- Electric tools: drills, saws, sewing machines, lawnmowers, ...
- Electric toys, electric sports and leisure devices
- White goods: washing machines, cookers, tumble driers, refrigerators, ...
- Lighting devices: fluorescent and energy saving lamps, discharging lamps, ...
- Medical devices: blood pressure measuring machines, ...
- Surveillance devices and vending machines: smoke detectors, heating regulators, thermostats, beverage vending machines, ...

Because of the danger of fire you have to separate batteries and accumulators that are not covered by a device and hand them over separately.

You can hand over old devices free of charge at the following centres:

Bulky large household devices such as refrigerators or freezers, washing machines, tumble driers, cookers or similar devices can be disposed of through the pick-up of bulky waste by request (this has to be registered in advance) or can be brought to the USK recycling centre during its opening times.

Small electric or electronic devices can be prepared for pick-up in the context of the regular household waste pick-up (see information on page 3).

In accordance with legal regulations all electric and electronic devices have to be part of separate disposal. They must not be disposed of with e.g. regular household waste. Affected devices mostly carry the symbol “Crossed waste bin”.

Separate waste disposal enormously contributes not only to the protection of the environment, but also of our health. For instance, this supports re-use, recycling or other types of exploitation. Also, it prevents damage from hazardous materials in such devices.

The disposal of electric or electronic devices from private households is carried out under the auspices of public waste disposal institutions. Furthermore, producers and distributors (e.g. shops) of such devices are obliged to take old devices back. Other types of “disposal” are not legal. When in doubt – ask us.

Which waste goes where?



Bulky waste (from households)

Bulky waste refers to movable household objects that even when they have been broken into smaller pieces do not fit into the regulars waste bins, could damage them or could make emptying bins enormously difficult.

As a rule, it is movable parts that you would take with you when you move house.

Pieces of bulky waste must not exceed dimensions of 1.5m x 0.75m x 0.5m and a weight of 75 kilograms.

YES, this is bulky waste (examples):

- Plastic tubs
- Bed frames
- Baskets
- Wooden shelves
- Petrol-driven lawnmowers, catchers for such lawnmowers
- Flower boxes
- Umbrella stands
- Duvets and mattresses
- Clothes drying racks
- Pieces of furniture
- Garden tools
- Bicycles
- Prams
- Carpet material
- Empty suitcases

NO, this is not bulky waste (examples):

- Doors
- Floor materials, eg laminate
- Construction waste
- Objects that were tightly connected to your house or property
- Organic waste
- Contaminated wood
- Bulky waste resulting from a household clearance
- Cardboard boxes, bags and other containers that are filled with waste
- Windows
- Wooden ceiling
- Mixed construction waste
- Sinks, toilets and other ceramic parts
- Car tires and car parts
- Buckets with paint and coating leftovers

Possibilities of disposal:

There are three possibilities for the citizens of Kleve to dispose of bulky waste.

a) Personal delivery to the disposal centre North/Kreis Kleve, Bedburg-Hau/Moyland (Alte Bahn)

Having presented your personal ID and after corresponding registration, you can leave bulky waste at the disposal centre of Kreis Kleve in Bedburg-Hau/Moyland. There is no additional fee.

b) Personal delivery to the USK recycling centre Kleve, 1 Wilhelm-Sinsteden-Straße (at corner Briener Straße)

Here you can also leave bulky waste without having to pay an additional fee.

IMPORTANT:

Bulky waste is accepted only in amounts that correspond to a normal household!!

The recycling centre is available only to citizens of Kleve. Therefore, you have to present your personal ID when delivering waste. Also, you have to prove on demand to centre staff that delivered waste is from the area of Kleve. It is sufficient to present a written note that says where the waste has accumulated and who owns the waste (name, address, phone number).

c) Disposal of bulky waste by request

If you cannot or do not want to make use of waste delivery to the disposal centre in Moyland or the USK recycling centre, you have the possibility to have bulky waste disposed on request. In this case, USK pick up bulky waste up to two times a year after corresponding registration. USK inform you of the pick-up day beforehand.

You can register in the following ways:

- by mail via the enclosed „bulky waste postcards“
- by Internet - www.kleve.de or www.usk-kleve.de
- by phone (02821 - 89 94 77)
- personally in the local city office or at USK.

After your registration we inform you about the pick-up day.

On pick-up day please leave your bulky waste in an orderly arrangement on the pavement by 6am. Please separate bulky electric devices as well as old metal and old wood. The whole amount of bulky waste has to be limited to 4 cubic metres or 500 kilograms. Furthermore, you can request this service only two times per year.

For the special service „Bulky waste disposal by request“ a fee of €30.00 has to be paid, which has been decided by the council of Kleve. Please note the following: When the date of pick-up is confirmed, you also receive an account number and invoice number; please transfer the fee to this account, giving the invoice number in the process. Alternatively, you can pay the fee in cash in advance at USK, 62 Brabanter Straße, in the Kleve local city office, 1 Minoritenstraße, and at the USK recycling centre, 1 Wilhelm-Sinsteden-Straße (at corner Briener Straße), ideally when you hand in your bulky waste postcard.

Important note: Bulky waste can be picked up only if the fee of €30.00 was paid in time beforehand. If you transfer the money, it has to be on the USK account at the latest 8 days before the intended day of pick-up.

The recycling centre is closed on Christmas Eve, New Year's Eve and New Year's Day.

Opening and running the recycling centre has raised the service level in the field of waste disposal for the citizens of Kleve considerably.

There is the opportunity to deliver various types of household waste at convenient opening times. However, only waste from private households in amounts that correspond to a normal household (up to 2 cubic metres or 200 kilograms) can be accepted. Industrial waste is not accepted!

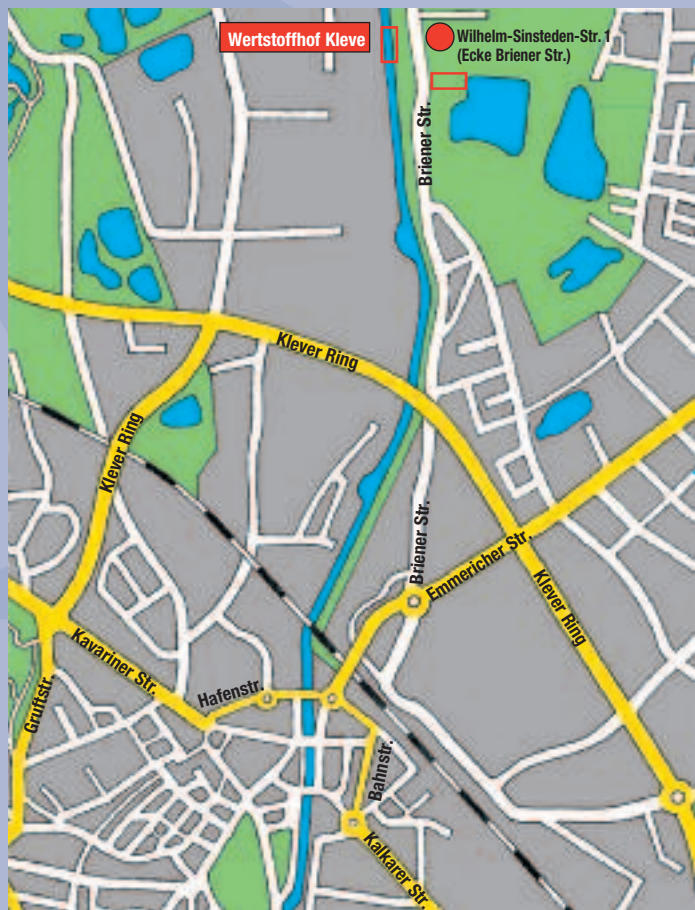
The following types of waste are accepted free of charge:

- Yellow recyclables bags
- Waste glass from the glass boxes
- Electric and electronic scrap, cable rests, household batteries (Old batteries and accumulators that are not covered by a waste device have to be separated!)
- Waste paper and cardboard
- Bulky waste (at most 4 deliveries per year and no more than 2 cubic metres or 200 kilograms per delivery)
- Bottle corks
- Scrap iron and metal
- Old clothes and shoes
- CDs, DVDs

Apart from that, the following types of waste are accepted for a fee and in amounts that correspond to a normal household:

- Household waste
- Organic household waste
- Garden and green waste (no root stocks)
- Construction wood (doors and windows, pallets, floor boards, wood planks, square timbers, chipboards, laminate, rustic fence, garden wood etc.)
- Contaminated wood (sleepers, telegraph poles, impregnated wood etc.)
- Construction waste
- Mixed construction waste (insulation material, onduline sheets, Heraklit boards; roof foil, waste resulting from house and flat renovation and from clearing out activities etc.)
- Flat glass
- Foil

We apply the fees that are valid in accordance with the regulations on the charge of fees for the disposal of waste in the town of Kleve. They are displayed at the recycling centre. The fees are also displayed on the Internet (www.kleve.de) and can be enquired at USK by phone on 89 94 77.



PLEASE NOTE:

The recycling centre is available only to citizens of Kleve. Therefore, you have to present your personal ID when delivering waste. Also, you have to prove on demand to centre staff that delivered waste is from the area of Kleve. It is sufficient to present a written note that says where the waste has accumulated and who owns the waste (name, address, phone number).

A TIP: Soil, construction waste and construction part market in the Internet

Materials and waste resulting from demolition and renovation work can in many cases be re-used. This corresponds to the targets of waste prevention and resources protection. For this, the state office for nature, environment and consumer protection NRW (LANUV), together with other involved parties, has developed a soil, construction waste and construction parts market, which is available online for use free of charge (ALOIS - Waste Online Information System): www.alois-info.de

Waste disposal vehicle with side loader technology

For quite some time USK have been using waste disposal vehicles that use the so-called side loader technology. However, the use of these vehicle requires you to place waste containers in a specific way. When this technology is used in your area for the first time, we will inform you in time and in detail. If in doubt, ask us.
